Now in its 40th year, the Trier Christmas Market is once again one of the loveliest in all of Germany. Beginning Friday, November 22, about 90 attractively decorated booths will be open until December 22. Set on the medieval Main Market and in front of the imposing backdrop of Trier Cathedral, the market is admired by visitors the world over. Only on Sunday, November 24, will the Christmas Market be closed because of the holiday on the Sunday before Advent on which the dead are commemorated. A varied program for the entire family changes almost daily, from historical puppet theater to star tenor or regional songsmiths. The Trier Christmas Market is often awarded the title "romantic with wonderful ambience." Every year, the widely varied program in front of the beautiful backdrop lures in many visitors from the world over. The only mulled wine queen in Germany is looking forward to the international guests in Trier. A large selection with delicious specialties such as the "Original Moselle Vintner Mulled Wine" or "mulled viez" (apple wine) is a great hit among the visitors from France, Luxembourg, and Belgium.
